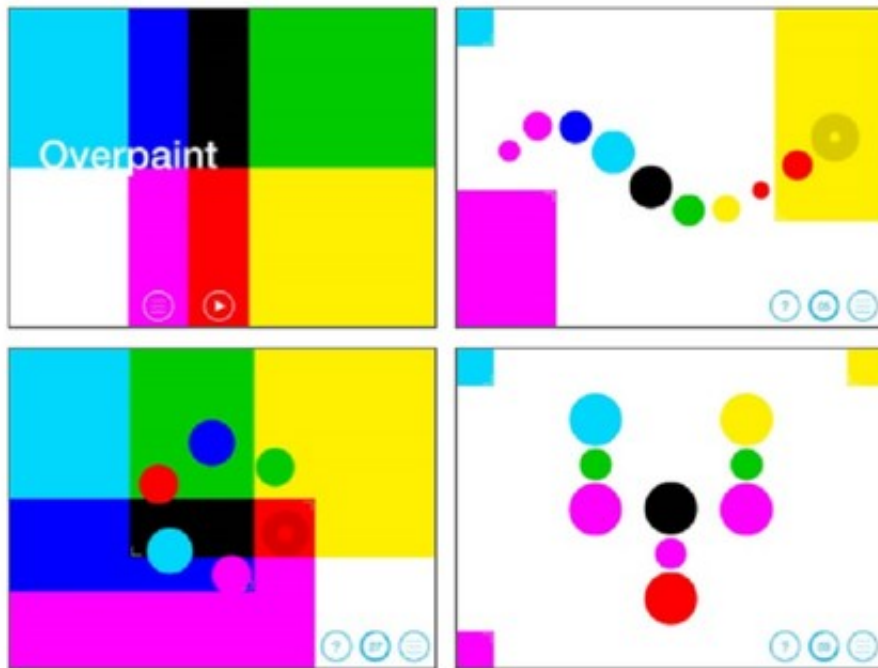


Overpaint app is addictive in a 'colorful' way

Overpaint became available for free download on iPad, iPhone, Mac, Android, Windows Phone and Kindle on March 19, which happened to be International Color Day.

This [game](#) is colorful and all about color.

The objective is to drag-and-drop the squares over the matching circles to clear them. To make new colors just overlap the 3 squares. It's easy at first, but gets more and more difficult.

It also gets addictive.

Features of Overpaint, per LANDKA (the app developer):

- *Free to play, no ads*
- *200 unique moving puzzles*
- *100 curious color facts*
- *Simple and clean design: less is beautiful!*
- *Easy to play but tricky to master*
- *Drag the squares by their corners and cover the circles*
- *Play at your own pace: think twice, slide once*
- *Challenge your friends and beat their scores*

Not sure what else I can say, as I need to get back and play Overpaint. It's addictive and challenging. For a free app, this is a "no brainer."
